


The French farce has arrived at 'The Farndale Avenue Housing Estate Townswomen's Guild Dramatic Society', and the formidable ladies do it like no one else! An unintelligible plot, a plethora of doors and a grand range of characters make this Farndale offering as bubbly as a glass of champagne.

Farndale Avenue comedies are hilarious. They are set in the fictitious world of the Farndale Avenue housing estate. The play is performed by the Townswomen's Guild's utterly disastrous attempt at putting on a classically familiar play. Five 'real' characters from the Guild: 4 women who play a myriad of parts and their stage manager Gordon who is reluctantly press-ganged onto the stage.

The Farndale folk's domestic squabbles and lives are played out while actually mid-production on stage, cues are missed and props disintegrate. The good ladies of the Guild largely wrongly assume they have got away with most of the shambles around them whilst also coming out of character and indulging in personal asides to the audience utterly unrelated to their show.

Audiences will be entertained and enjoy a marvellous evening's performance. There are no deep meanings or underlying truths just great comedy!

Health and Safety at the Theatre

Our health and safety policies continue to be implemented. Please take a look at the notices and the information that is available. We have already made good progress and thank you for your help with the new procedures.

- There is a new evacuation policy (mainly for show nights) and evacuation training will be advertised now that the new fire alarm install is completed
- We are in the process of rolling out new Front of House policies along with a cleaning policy, and FoH training on food, hygiene/evacuation/safety.
- We will have specific Bar training objectives for practical bar training.
- We are currently reviewing our policies on handling hazardous substances, equipment, and some other aspects of safety, and you may have seen posters about the use of portable heaters and bringing in your own electrical items. Members who work in small to medium/large organisations will notice many of the policies are similar to their work as they are implementing Health and Safety Executive advice.
