## Lilies on the Land

6th - 8th March 2025



**Helen, Linda, Lucy and Benita** give you an insight into lives on the farm during the second world war and tell their stories with humour as well as horror. Expecting sunny days in the fresh air happily tossing hay (that the recruitment posters had promised), they were rudely awakened to the realities of life on the land.

#### The question is how would you cope?

- Shut in a barn surrounded by rats
- Having to use a hole in the middle of field as a toilet
- Dealing with unpleasant farmers and unwanted attentions from insistent men
- Being knee deep in pig shit or slimy mud
- Spending long hours in back-breaking hoeing and planting

Our Lilies tell how they managed to survive their exposure to a new and strange life and how they supported each other and grew strong. Their frozen hands were warmed between the cow's udders and they found strength to deliver a calf, transformed with joy at the miracle of birth. This play will make you laugh, occasionally make you cry, and you cannot help but leave the theatre with admiration for the courage and fortitude of this 'forgotten army'. This funny and moving production is a fitting tribute to the girls who kept wartime Britain fed.

Pete and Heidi Ashton are our new front of house co-ordinators, and they would like you to join the front of house volunteers.



## **Calendar Girls**

We are very excited to present Calendar Girls on the Shinfield stage this October.

The death of a much-loved husband prompts a group of ordinary women in a small Yorkshire Women's Institute to do an extraordinary thing. Blasting away all preconceptions of what it is to be in a Women's Institute, they decide to do an artistic nude calendar to raise money for charity.

Upturning preconceptions is a dangerous business and none of them expect the emotional and personal ramifications, but gradually the making of the fabulous and funny calendar brings each woman unexpectedly into flower.

But don't think this is just a play for middle aged women. There are also 5 great male roles, 3 teenagers, plus ensemble (of all ages) creating the community of Knapely.

Shinfield regulars will already be familiar with the work of Tim Firth whose shows include Our House and The Safari Party, as well as Kinky Boots. Gary Barlow is best known for Take That, but he also wrote the music and lyrics to Finding Neverland prior to collaborating with Tim on this musical version of Calendar Girls.

The true story of the Calendar Girls launched a global phenomenon, a million copycat calendars, a record-breaking movie, stage play and this musical which coined the term "craughing" - the act of crying and laughing at the same time.

With unforgettable songs, every performance continues to add to the millions already raised for charity and prove that there is no such thing as an ordinary woman.

This heartwarming show will be produced by the same team that brought you our super-successful pantomime Snow White and the Four Swedish Popstars:




